Call to Order

Meeting called to order by Jon Schultz, followed by the Pledge, approval of previous minutes and, introductions.

Presentation

Reworld-Alan Davis, Operations Manager- Reworld is a sustainable solutions company that focuses on zero landfill options. A lot of companies want their waste out of landfills, and will do whatever they have to do to get it out of the landfill. Some options Reworld offers, ReDirect360 which diverts waste from landfills, ReKilns waste that becomes fuel that replaces fossil fuels. ReDrop is a wastewater solution that treats water and goes into waste energy plants for direct injection. ReMove Logistics is a waste removal, transport and disposal of materials. ReCredit is a carbon offset solution that helps businesses meet emission goals through renewable energy credits.

Facility Locations are throughout Niagara County, and a Hazardous Waste Facility in Ohio. Frontier Fibers takes residuals from GreenPac Paper Mill and fibers are mixed with kiln dust or lime and treat it and is then sold to farmers as animal bedding. A material processing facility (MPF), which is like a transfer station, take materials to process it first to get it into a format that the TTF (thermomechanical treatment facility) can burn it for energy.

Notifications and Updates

Reaching out to EPA to get a representative to a meeting. 2026 is the 250th Anniversary of the Country, the Air Show is also happening next year.

Reworld- recently had training for HazOp awareness to update some Hazmat drivers along with fire extinguisher training with all personnel.

CISA-back in operations after the government shut down, still doing assessments. CFATS is not coming back at this point, but they hired a director for it.

Niagara Falls Water Board-NYS has issued draft cybersecurity regulations for water and waste water systems, we're reviewing these to see what needs to be changed. Extending an invitation to host a meeting at the Water Board, and take a short tour of the facility.

NCEMS- extending operations to 24hrs

Niagara County Water Department- held to the same rules and regs with NYS, already started implementing changes

Niagara County Legislature- passed the 2026 budget, including the budget to provide the nighttime portion of the ambulance service.
