K. Alexander provided an update on the building lease repairs at 1961 Transit Rd, Newfane. She stated the required work has not yet been completed and we have filed a notice to the landlord to execute our right to hire outside contractors to complete the repairs. Public Works is in the process of obtaining quotes for the necessary repairs. K. Alexander also stated the County hired ServPro to complete an emergency repair to the building and, as per the terms of the lease, we will be withholding rent for the month of September and part of October for reimbursement of the emergency repairs.

POSITION APPOINTMENT COMMISSIONER OF NIAGARA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, under the Local Law establishing an Administration Code for the County of Niagara, the County Manager shall make appointments for the position of Commissioner of Economic Development subject to the confirmation of the County Legislature, and

WHEREAS, Andrea Klyczek has served as Deputy Commissioner since 2018, during which time she has spearheaded initiatives such as the Façade and Production Programs, the Niagara County Microenterprise Program, and the establishment and expansion of the Niagara Orleans Regional Land Improvement Corporation (NORLIC), which has secured over \$3M in grant funding for property rehabilitation across the County, and

WHEREAS, the County Manager has reviewed annual performance evaluations of Andrea Klyczek and has determined that Ms. Klyczek exceeds performance requirements for the position, and

WHEREAS, Ms. Klyczek has concurrently held the position of Executive Director of the Niagara County Industrial Development Agency (NCIDA) since June 1, 2024, following her prior role as Assistant Director, thereby facilitating integrated economic development services through a shared position between the NCIDA and the Department of Economic Development, and

WHEREAS, the review by the NCIDA has determined Andrea Klyczek surpasses all expectations in her position as Executive Director, and

WHEREAS, the NCIDA is currently in a shared service agreement with the County, date which expires December 31, 2025, and

WHEREAS, NCIDA desires to continue to use the services of the Niagara County Commissioner of Economic Development and enter into a new Administrative Services Contract with the County, and

WHEREAS, upon review and consideration and recommendation for appointment by the County Manager, it has been determined that Andrea Klyczek best meets the qualifications for the position of Commissioner of the Niagara County Department of Economic Development, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Andrea Klyczek is hereby appointed to a five-year term as Commissioner of the Niagara County Department of Economic Development, effective October 22, 2025 through October 21, 2030, beginning at an annualized salary of \$140,000, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of the Niagara County Department of Economic Development shall be entitled to further increases in compensation, and all the benefits normally granted to Department Heads for the duration of the appointment, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the existing agreement between Niagara County and the Niagara County Industrial Development Agency shall remain in place until December 31, 2025, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the salary and benefits in the subsequent years of this appointment will be shared by the County and the Niagara County Industrial Development Agency, whereby the NCIDA will pay 50% of the then current salary along with 50% of the benefits and other costs to be billed to NCIDA monthly by Niagara County, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Niagara County Attorney's Office is authorized to review and negotiate the shared services agreement with the Niagara County Industrial Development Agency, formalizing the continued collaboration and integration of economic development services between the two entities, and be it further

RESOLVED, that following the County Attorney's review, the shared service agreement between the Niagara County Industrial Development Agency and Niagara County may be executed pursuant to the Niagara County Contract Policy.

APPOINTMENT: DIRECTOR OF REAL PROPERTY TAX SERVICES III

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 1530 of the New York State Real Property Tax Law, the Niagara County Legislature shall appoint a Director of the Real Property Tax Services Agency (RPTS) who shall have a six year term expiring on September 30, 2025, and

WHEREAS, the current Director, Tracy Farrell, was appointed on May 28, 2024, and has been fulfilling the remainder of the prior Director's six year term which commenced on October 1st, 2019 and ends on September 30th, 2025, and

WHEREAS, the Director shall be appointed based upon his/her knowledge of principles and methods relating to the assessment of real property and his executive and administrative experience, and

WHEREAS, Tracy Farrell is a New York State certified County Director of RPTS, thus meeting the qualifications standards for said office as established by the New York State Office of Real Property Tax Services, and

WHEREAS, Tracy Farrell is an expert in the area of real property tax administration and tax services, and

WHEREAS, the County Manager has determined that Tracy Farrell has performed successfully in the capacity of Director of Real Property Tax Services and recommends the appointment of Tracy Farrell to Director of Real Property Tax Services III subject to confirmation by the County Legislature, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Tracy Farrell, be appointed the Director of RPTS for a six (6) year term commencing October 1st, 2025 through September 30th, 2031, and be it further

RESOLVED, that beginning January 1, 2026 Tracy Farrell shall be compensated as FLSA exempt at an annualized salary of \$84,475; \$87,580 beginning January 1, 2027; \$90,685 beginning January 1, 2028; \$93,790 beginning January 1, 2029; \$96,895 beginning January 1, 2030; and \$100,000 for the period beginning January 1, 2031 through the end of her appointment, and be it further

RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded by the Clerk of the Legislature to the Executive Director of the New York State Office of Real Property Tax Services, WA Harriman State Campus, Albany, New York 12227.
