

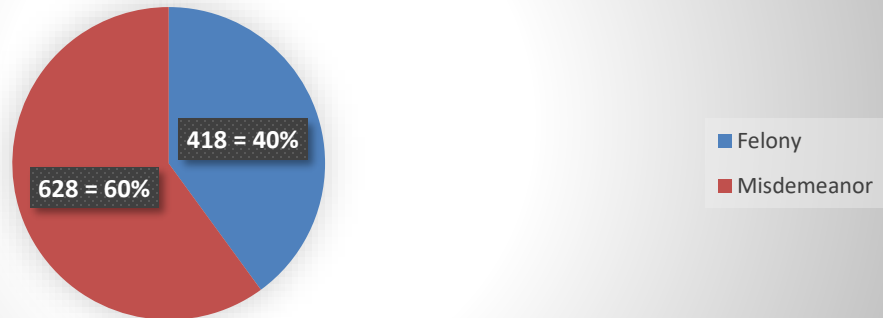

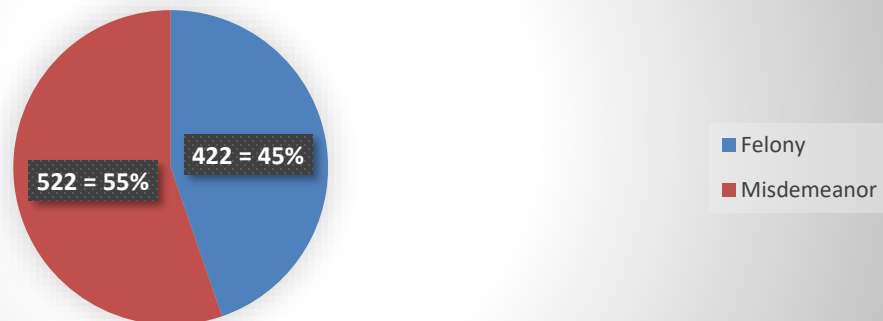


2024 CRIMINAL COURT UNIT STATISTICS

1,046 Pre-Sentence Investigations Completed



944 Supervision Cases as of 12/31/24



Supervision cases increased 6% from 2023 totals.

Gun Involved Violence Elimination – GIVE

The Probation Department partners with the Niagara Falls Police Department, the Niagara County Sheriff's Office, and the Niagara County District Attorney's Office on this initiative to help control gun violence in Niagara Falls, NY.

In 2024, 30 GIVE operations were conducted, resulting in 262 contacts with individuals on the GIVE workload. During the operations seven people were arrested for new charges, either gun or drug related. In addition, five illegal guns were recovered and removed from the community.

2024 TASC UNIT STATISTICS

The Niagara County TASC Program is an alternative to incarceration program designed to reduce the burdens on the criminal justice system by providing eligible defendants with access to substance use treatment, among other service needs, with the aim of reducing the likelihood of recidivism and enhancing public safety.

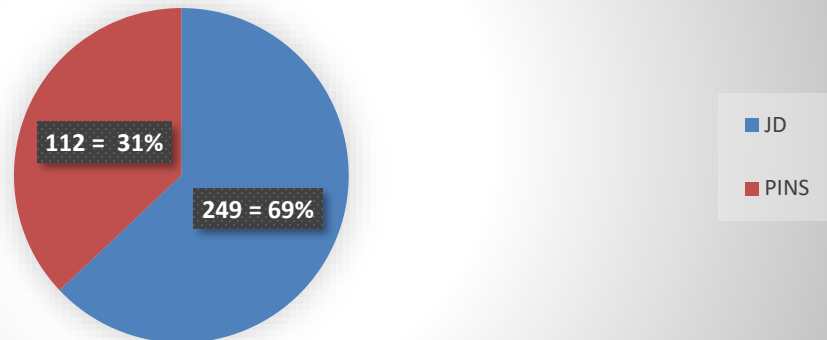

Goal of the Family Court system is to adjust intake cases, avoiding Family Court intervention/petition.

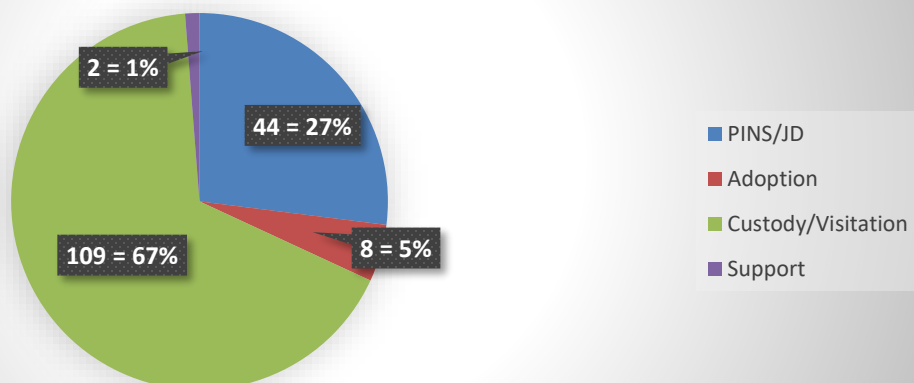
361 Intake Cases Opened
