## Sign Up for Fraud Alert to Protect Your Home


Niagara County is offering a free service to help protect residents from title fraud. Fraud Alert is a tool provided through the Niagara County Clerk's office that alerts people whenever a document, such as a deed or a mortgage, is recorded under their names with the Clerk.

To sign up, go to the Search IQS Fraud Alert website at <https://searchiqs.com/fraudalert/?CC=NYNIA> (download this document to activate link) where you will sign up by entering your email address to

receive alerts for yourself (and others if you wish); agree to the Terms and Conditions; select "I am not a robot;" and then click sign up. You will then receive an email to confirm your account and verify your email address. The whole process takes five minutes, which is well worth it to know you are protecting your most valuable asset— your home.

## County Participates in Operation Greenlight to Honors Veterans

Operation Greenlight is a nationwide program designed to not only honor the men and women who served in our armed forces, but also highlight the services and programs available to help them. Niagara County was one of more than 450 counties nationwide to take part in this campaign by lighting the flagpole outside the county courthouse green.
