<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> Positions in this class involve the performance of clerical work in accordance with a prescribed routine. births and deaths are registered in accordance with the rules and regulations of the State Department of Health. The work involves frequent public contact. Acts in place of and assists the Registrar of Vital Statistics in recording births and deaths. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Files birth and death records;
- 2. Issues birth and marriage certificates and copies of death certificates;
- 3. Issues burial permits to undertakers;
- 4. Assists with delayed registrations of persons whose births have not been recorded;
- 5. Reports births and deaths to the State Department of Health.
