The Legislature of the County of Niagara, State of New York, convened in annual session in the Legislature Chambers, Courthouse, Lockport, New York on Tuesday, January 5, 2021 for the purpose of electing officers for the ensuing year.

County Clerk Joseph Jastrzemski, acting as Chairman pro temp, called the Legislature meeting to order at 6:05 p.m. and gave the invocation.

A moment of silence was held for Vanessa Walker and former Legislator Philo J. Brooks.

REGIONAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN NIAGARA AND ERIE COUNTY TO PERFORM AUTOPSY SERVICES

WHEREAS, Niagara County and Erie County entered into an agreement in 2002 that allows the Erie County Medical Examiner's Office to perform all of Niagara County's autopsies, which agreement has subsequently been renewed, and

WHEREAS, the current agreement will expire December 31, 2020, and

WHEREAS, Erie County has offered us a one-year agreement at \$2,100/full autopsy and \$1,350/external exam, along with other associated fees, and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial for Niagara County to continue this practice and promote regionalism and shared services between the counties of Niagara and Erie, and

WHEREAS, prior to the execution of the agreement, the County Attorney will review the agreement for approval as to legal form, language and compliance, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that following the County Attorney's review, the County of Niagara does hereby agree to the terms and conditions in said agreement and authorizes the Chairman of the Legislature to execute the contract with Erie County and the Erie County Medical Examiner's Office.
