Section 2	Purnose. It is the nurno	ose of this Local Law to con	ofirm the	commitmen	nt of Niag	ara County

Section 3. Authority: An assistant district attorney is a local public officer. Those holding that office are, therefore, subject to the provisions of section 3 of the Public Officers Law, which requires residency in the county within which their functions are exercised. Section 10(1)(ii)(a)(1) of the Municipal Home Rule Law, empowers a county to adopt local laws that are not inconsistent with the constitution or any general law,

retain her experience in the Office of the District Attorney.

to hire residents who have the necessary qualifications and skills to meet the requirements of the position of Assistant District Attorney of Niagara County. This law will permit Niagara County to make an exception to the residency requirement of the Public Officers Law for Assistant District Attorney Lisa Baehre in order to including the residency of its officers and employees. The County of Niagara can supersede Section 3 of the Public Officer's Law with respect to the office of Assistant District Attorney, in that section 3 has become a special rather than a general law due to the exemption of the counties of Essex, Fulton, Madison, Montgomery, Putnam, Schuyler, Wyoming, and Yates, in that it does not by its terms, apply alike to the office of district attorney in every county.

<u>Section 4</u>. *Authorization:* The District Attorney is hereby authorized to make an exception to the residency requirement to retain Lisa Baehre in Niagara County as an Assistant District Attorney.

Section 5. Effect: This Local Law shall take effect upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State pursuant to the provisions of Article 3 section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

NIAGARA COUNTY REFUSE DISPOSAL DISTRICT CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS LANDFILL CLOSURE AND SITE UPGRADES CONTRACT WITH MARK CERRONE, INC. (REF 02-2016 C&D) REGARDING THE CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION DEBRIS LANDFILL CLOSURE: C&D LANDFILL PROPOSED CHANGE ORDER #9 FOR TIME EXTENSION

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Refuse Disposal District (hereinafter referred to as "NCRDD") entered into the Niagara County Refuse Disposal District Construction and Demolition Debris Landfill Closure and Site Upgrades Contract (REF 02-2016 C&D), (hereinafter referred to as "Contract") with Mark Cerrone, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "MCI") on July 18, 2016 to effect the closure of the landfill facility in Lockport, New York designated as the Construction and Demolition Debris Landfill (hereinafter referred to as "C&D") in accordance with New York State Department of Environmental Conservation Operating Permit No. 32-D-10, and

WHEREAS, the unambiguous terms of the Contract require MCI to effectuate "Substantial Completion" of all of MCI's obligations under said Contract within one hundred twenty-seven (127) days of the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed" by NCRDD to MCI, and

WHEREAS, NCRDD issued the "Notice to Proceed" to MCI on July 18, 2016, which mandated MCI to effectuate "Substantial Completion" of all of MCI's obligations under said Contract by or before November 22, 2016, and

WHEREAS, MCI communicated to NCRDD on or about October 13, 2016 that MCI would not be effectuating "Substantial Completion" of all of MCI's unambiguous contractual obligations stated in the Contract by the required date of November 22, 2016, and

WHEREAS, NCRDD and MCI subsequent to October 13, 2016 entered into several discussions and communications in an effort to resolve the various Contract, construction schedule, and logistical issues concerning the C&D closure and site upgrades caused solely by MCI's failure to achieve "Substantial Completion" of all of MCI's obligations under said Contract by or before November 22, 2016, and

WHEREAS, MCI sent a letter (erroneously dated November 2, 2016) to CHA Consulting, Inc. RESOLŬTION URGING THE ASSEMBLY TO CEASE BLOCKING EQUAL ACCESS TO UBER AND LYFT CAR SERVICES IN UPSTATE NEW YORK, A PRIVILEGE THE STATE OF NEW YORK ONLY GRANTS TO NEW YORK CITY

WHEREAS, under New York State's law, the popular Uber and Lyft rideshare services are only legally permitted to operate in New York City, providing a fundamental imbalance in economic opportunity and access to affordable transportation that benefits New York City while hurting Upstate New York, and

WHEREAS, the lack of access to Uber and Lyft is particularly acute in rural areas not serviced by public transit systems, and would provide an affordable tool for accessing large-scale public transit, including the Niagara Frontier Transit Authority's bus routes, and

WHEREAS, the Senate did pass legislation in 2016 that would allow Uber and Lyft access to Upstate markets, but the legislation was blocked in the New York City-controlled Assembly, with the New York Daily News stating in its June 20, 2016 edition that the Assembly's refusal to pass that legislation was because "the powerful state trial lawyers, who are close to the Assembly Democrats, were pushing for more comprehensive insurance coverage," and

WHEREAS, this Legislature finds it appalling that the access of the citizens of the County of Niagara, and most especially senior citizens and those with developmental disabilities, to reliable transportation that would increase their access to such things as medical facilities and doctor's offices, popular recreation and entertainment destinations, post-secondary educational facilities, and mass transit lines in general, has been held hostage to the whims of powerful moneyed interests in Albany, and urges that the Assembly enact legislation permitting access to Lyft and Uber at the earliest opportunity, and

WHEREAS, this Legislature further must endorse the net positive economic impact of said legislation, as the Honorable Robert G. Ortt, Senator for the 62<sup>nd</sup> District noted, in a recent communication to district residents, that "an estimated 78 percent of passengers spend more money at local businesses because of ridesharing services," and the lack of ride-sharing services must be viewed as detrimental to our economy in light of this face, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Legislature of the County of Niagara does hereby call upon the New York State Assembly to cease blocking legislation providing Upstate residents with access to Uber and Lyft and to enact such legislation at the earliest opportunity, and be it further

RESOLUTION URGING CONGRESS TO PASS LEGISLATION, H.R. 6397, "PROTECTION OF MILITARY AIRFIELDS FROM WIND TURBINE ENCROACHMENT ACT" AND PRESIDENT-ELECT DONALD J. TRUMP TO ENACT THE SAME

WHEREAS, it has been contended that the proposed Apex Clean Energy wind turbine farm, which would be situated along the Lake Ontario shore in the Town of Somerset, would present a navigational hazard that would be deleterious to the mission of the Niagara Falls Air Reserve Station, and

WHEREAS, mindful of the complexities of emerging threats to national security, and remembering the specific challenges to the airspace above New York State presented by the 9/11 terrorist attacks, this Legislature deplores any action that could reduce military readiness of the United States, and

WHEREAS, this Legislature must further object to any action by a monied interest, such as Apex, that could have a net negative impact on the finances of the County of Niagara and its citizens, and fully aware that the Niagara Falls Air Reserve Station generates a positive impact exceeding \$200 million annually throughout the regional economy of Western New York, and employs nearly 3,000 Western New Yorkers directly, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Defense did announce in February 2016 that the Niagara Falls Air Reserve Station will be home to an Air Force Reserve KC-135 aerial refueling mission, and NFARS further is slated to be the home for command and control assets of an Unmanned Aerial Vehicle Remote Split Operations Squadron, and

WHEREAS, the sitting of wind turbines exceeding 600 feet in height could have a damaging effect on the ability of the Niagara Falls Air Reserve Station to take on either mission, and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Chris Collins, U.S. Representative for the 27<sup>th</sup> District, which includes the Niagara Falls Air Reserve Station, did introduce on November 29<sup>th</sup> of this year legislation, H.R. 6397, the Protection of Military Airfields from Wind Turbine Encroachment Act, and

WHEREAS, the Protection of Military Airfields from Wind Turbine Encroachment Act would make corporations owning wind turbine farms located within 40 miles of a military airfield ineligible for tax breaks for the same, and

WHEREAS, such legislation has been enthusiastically endorsed by the governmental leadership of the Town of Somerset and the neighboring Town of Yates in Orleans County, where the proposed wind turbine farm would be located, and

WHEREAS, this Legislature has long been committed to a policy of protecting the Niagara Falls Air Reserve Station from closure due to BRAC processes and other threats to its ongoing operation, and has invested many hundreds of thousands of public dollars in that cause, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Legislature of the County of Niagara does urge the United States Congress to take up and pass H.R. 6397 at the earliest opportunity, and urges that the Ways and Means Committee move its passage to the floor for a full vote at the earliest opportunity, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Legislature of the County of Niagara does further urge the Honorable Donald J. Trump, President-Elect of the United States, to sign such legislation into law upon its passage, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County of Niagara shall forward copies of this Resolution to Representative Collins; the Honorable Kevin Brady, Chairman, House Ways and Means Committee; the Honorable Kevin McCarthy, House Majority Leader; the Honorable Paul Ryan, Speaker of the House; the Honorable Charles E. Schumer, U.S. Senator for New York; the Honorable Kirsten E. Gillibrand, U.S. Senator for New York; the Honorable Donald J.
