COUNTY CLERK OFFICE CONTRACT AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the appropriate, accurate and timely management of local government records is essential for efficient and effective government, and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Clerk's Office has experienced a significant backlog in the indexing and verification of legal land documents and records, and

WHEREAS, said backlog of indexing and verification of legal land documents and records was caused by extraordinary circumstances including, but not limited to, multiple retirements, resignations, COVID -19 related staff shortages as well as numerous other unforeseen staffing challenges, and

WHEREAS, despite increased overtime efforts by the Niagara County Clerk's Office Staff, the said backlog persists and is perpetuating, and

WHEREAS, it has been mutually agreed by Niagara County and the Union that an Amendment to the Contract between Niagara County and Info Quick Solutions, Inc. dated February 18, 2014 is both necessary, practical, and desirable to address the backlog, and

WHEREAS, Info Quick Solutions, Inc. possesses the necessary skill and expertise to eliminate the aforementioned backlog of indexing and verification of legal land documents and records, and

WHEREAS, except for this Amendment, all other terms and Amendments to the original Contract dated February 18, 2014 shall remain unchanged and in force, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Niagara County enter an Amendment to the Contract with Info Quick-Solutions, Inc. dated April 27, 2022 to provide indexing and verification services of the aforementioned backlogged documents for the period commencing January 14, 2022 and terminating April 20, 2022, and be it further

RESOLVED, that any time extensions to the January 14, 2022 – April 20, 2022 time period will require a mutually agreed upon written amendment signed by authorized representatives of the County and the Union, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized to execute the attached agreement, subject to the review by the County Manager and the approval of the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Niagara County Treasurer's Office is hereby authorized to disburse an amount not to exceed \$13,300.00 from the County Clerk's Appropriated Fund Balance – Committed Funds Account A.10.1410 40599.01 into the County Clerk's operating budget, and be it further

TRANSFER OF 6805 DAY ROAD PROPERTY HOME RULE MESSAGE SENATE BILL NO. S.6313-B AND ASSEMBLY BILL NO. A.7837-B

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara received certain lands from transfers in 1962 on the condition that they be used for park and recreational purposes, and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara has not pursued the development of these lands and does not have any immediate plans to do so and the Town of Lockport expressed an interest in November of 2020 in acquiring this land and developing on the land, park and recreational activities, and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. IF-013-21, the County authorized the entering into an agreement to transfer premises known as 6805 Day Road, identified by Tax SBL #110.00-1-30.1, and requesting the New York State Senate and the New York State Assembly to initiate legislation; to execute all further necessary paperwork to accomplish the transfer pursuant to that agreement, and

WHEREAS, the property is further described in the following proposed legal description:

ALL THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND situated in the Town of Lockport, County of Niagara, and State of New York, being part of Lot 8, Section 10, Township 14, Range 6 of the Holland Land Company's Survey, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point of intersection of the centerline of East High Street (being 66.0 feet wide), also being the south line of Lot 8 and the extension of the west line of Day Road (being 66.0 feet wide), said point also being the southeasterly corner of lands conveyed to the Town of Lockport as filed by deed in the Niagara County Clerk's Office in Liber 3378 of Deeds at Page 281;

Thence, N 06° -49' -50" W, along the west line of Day road, also being the east line said lands conveyed to the Town of Lockport, a distance of 1780.00 feet to the Point of Beginning;

Thence, N 90° -00' -00" W, parallel with the centerline of East High Street, also being the north line said lands conveyed to the Town of Lockport, a distance of 1190.73 feet to a point on the west line Lot 8;

Thence, N 05° -49' -31" W, along said west line Lot 8, a distance of 2213.82 feet to a point on the north line Lot 8;

Thence, N 89° -55' -46" E, along said north line Lot 8, a distance of 1151.45 feet to a point on the west line Day Road, also being the west line lands conveyed to the Town of Lockport as filed by deed in the Niagara County Clerk's Office in Liber 1295 of Deeds at Page 105;

Thence, S 06° -49' -50" E, along said west line of lands conveyed to the Town of Lockport, a distance of 2219.56 feet to the Point of Beginning. Containing 58.23 acres of land, more or less.

WHEREAS, as part of the agreement of transfer, the Town of Lockport shall continue to make all park areas and improvements equally available to both Town and County residents and shall not enact any fees or charges which are higher for any County residents who are not Town residents, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Lockport shall continue to comply with Article 6-C of the Conservation Law of the State of New York as it existed at the time the County acquired title to said property, and

WHEREAS, the transfer of the Day Road property is dependent upon the approval of the New York State Legislature, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Article IX of the Constitution, the Niagara County Legislature requests that the New York State Legislature enact legislation, Senate Bill S.6313-B and Assembly Bill A.7837-B, enabling the transfer of 6805 Day Road property, in the Town of Lockport (SBL #110.00-1-30.1) to the Town of Lockport, and be it further

SUPPORT FOR LOCKPORT'S RAILYARD SKATE PARK 2022 PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Niagara Power Coalition ("NPC") and the New York Power Authority (NYPA) agreed to a licensing settlement for the next 50 years for the Niagara Power Project, and

WHEREAS, that settlement allows Niagara County to receive, through NPC Host Community Standing Committee ("HCSC"), up to \$390,000 annually to fund projects which are found to be consistent with the Niagara Greenway projects along the Greenway Trail, and

WHEREAS, Lockport Community Services, Inc. has made application to the Niagara County's Ad Hoc Committee on Parks, Recreation and Tourism for Greenway funds for the Lockport's Railyard Skate Park 2022 Project which consists of the construction of a concrete skateboarding park, and

WHEREAS, the Railyard Skateboarding Park, is a wooden above ground park that opened in the spring of 2007 near the community pool at Outwater Memorial Park in Lockport to meet the recreational needs of the youth in the community, and

WHEREAS, since its opening, the Railyard Skate Park has been utilized by many as the interest in skateboarding and BMX has increased dramatically over the years, and

WHEREAS, the costs of repairing the wooden structure have been problematic and at times expensive for skate surface materials, and

WHEREAS, in the spring of 2019, the Friends of the Railyard Skate Park and Lockport Community Services, Inc., along with support of the City of Lockport, received a matching grant from the Tony Hawk (now known as The Skate Park Project) and Ralph C. Wilson, Jr. Foundation's Built to Play initiative, which provided matching grants for 20 communities in Western New York and eastern Michigan to build concrete public skate parts, and
