APPROVAL OF VOTING MACHINE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NIAGARA AND THE NIAGARA FALLS, LOCKPORT, NORTH TONAWANDA, BARKER, LEW-PORT, NEWFANE, NIAGARA WHEATFIELD, ROY-HART, STARPOINT, AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS

(§3-224, NEW YORK STATE ELECTION LAW)

WHEREAS, the Niagara Falls, Lockport, North Tonawanda, Barker, Lew-port, Newfane, Niagara Wheatfield, Roy-Hart, Starpoint, Wilson School Districts will be conducting an election on May 17, 2016 and requires the use of the Niagara County Board of Elections voting equipment in connection with this election, and

WHEREAS, the Niagara County Attorney's Office has prepared a formal agreement for use between the County of Niagara and the Niagara Falls, Lockport, North Tonawanda, Barker, Lew-port, Newfane, Niagara Wheatfield, Roy-Hart, Starpoint, Wilson School District, which has been fully approved by the District, a copy of which has been filed with the Clerk of the Legislature, and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence in connection with the approvals by the Niagara County Legislature, and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the agreement the County will provide, and be reimbursed for transportation of the voting machine preparation, programming, and packaging of the voting machine and all necessary Niagara County personnel: the District, among other things, shall furnish at its expense, election custodians and inspectors and also insurance in form, content and amounts as approved by the Niagara County Attorney, and

WHEREAS, the final written agreement between the parties is subject to the review and approval by the parties' respective legal counsel, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that pursuant to the provisions of §3-224 of New York State Election Law, the Chair of the Niagara County Legislature and the Niagara County Election Commissioners are authorized and directed to execute and deliver an agreement, in substantially the form of agreement now filed with the Clerk of the Legislature between and among the County of Niagara, the Niagara County Election Commissioners and the Niagara Falls, Lockport, North Tonawanda, Barker, Lew-port, Newfane, Niagara Wheatfield, Roy-Hart, Starpoint, Wilson School Districts for the provision, by the County of Niagara, of sufficient voting equipment, including the programming thereof, to the Niagara Falls, Lockport, North Tonawanda, Barker, Lew-port, Newfane, Niagara Wheatfield, Roy-Hart, Starpoint, Wilson School Districts in connection with an election scheduled to be held the 17th day of May 2016, and be it further

NIAGARA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE CREATE PT TYPIST – ABOLISH 2 SEASONAL POSITIONS

WHEREAS, protocol for surrendering weapons in Niagara County was previously shared by the Niagara County Pistol Permit Office and the Sheriff's Office, and

WHEREAS, weapons are surrendered for various reasons such as court orders or from families of individuals who have passed away and must surrender their guns for proper disposal, and

WHEREAS, there has been a change in the procedure of surrendering handguns and the Sheriff's Office has become the sole repository for the weapons, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office will more than double the number of weapons we receive, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office must inventory, store, maintain and dispose of these weapons when legally required, and

WHEREAS, the process of returning or disposing of the weapons may take years to resolve due to court action or legal requirements, and

WHEREAS, the increase in paperwork for handling this necessitates the need to hire a part-time Clerical 1, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has part-time seasonal positions and we will abolish two of these positions to help fund the creation of the part-time Typist, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the position of part-time Typist, job group 3, at an hourly rate of \$15.85 with no fringe benefits be created and filled effective May 9, 2016, and be it further

RESOLVED, that seasonal Laborer position No. 13116 at an hourly rate of \$10.00 per hour and seasonal Clerical, position No. 13121 at an hourly rate of \$10.00 per hour be abolished effective May 8, 2016, and be it further

WHEREAS, Niagara County supports those activities designed to enhance quality of life for residents as a critical facet in convincing businesses to locate high-wage jobs in this county, and deems a "family-friendly" environment essential to the economic development of the Western New York region, and

WHEREAS, youth athletics have long been a critical part of the appeal of municipalities in this county as "bedroom communities" for the local workforce, and

WHEREAS, the Niagara Erie Youth Sports Association administrates a 16-club, four weight-division youth football league in Niagara and Erie counties, and is responsible for the health and safety of youth athletes aged 6 to 14, as well as spectators and support personnel at NEYSA football games, and

WHEREAS, according to information provided by the American Heart Association, 56% of cardiacarrest deaths in athletes were attributable to cardiovascular disease, with 82% of those deaths occurring as a result of physical exertion during competition or training, and a National Collegiate Athletic Association study of high school and college-aged athletes found an incidence of cardiac arrest of 1 per 22,903 athlete participant years, and that the survival rate among children with non-traumatic cardiac arrest is just 7.8%, and

WHEREAS, a Harvard study indicated that utilization of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) in combination with cardiopulmonary resuscitation increased the survival rate to 23%, and

WHEREAS, adequate safety equipment is essential to the management of youth athletics and to lower liabilities, and

WHEREAS, NEYSA has received a quoted price of \$5,250 to acquire 6 AED devices, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Niagara County supports youth athletics and specifically wishes to see the Niagara Erie Youth Sports Association's regional football league continue to provide a positive outlet for youth that enhances quality of life for families residing in the Western New York region, and be it further
