The salary of the Niagara County Treasurer shall be increased in the sum of \$1,000, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1976, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactively to January 1, 1976, the annual salary of the Niagara County Treasurer shall be \$19,750.
- 2. The salary of the Public Defender shall be increased in the sum of \$701, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1976, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactively to January 1, 1976, the annual salary of the Public Defender shall be \$13,934.
- 3. The salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be increased in the sum of \$500, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1976, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactively to January 1, 1976, the annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be \$21,525.
- 4. The salary of the County Attorney shall be increased in the sum of \$943, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1976, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactively to January 1, 1976, the annual salary of the County Attorney shall be \$18,733.
- 5. The salary of the Commissioners of Election shall be increased in the sum of \$800 each, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1976, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactively to January 1, 1976, the annual salary of the Commissioners of Election shall be \$12,725.

- 6. The salary of the Probation Director shall be increased in the sum of \$1,000, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1976, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactively to January 1, 1976, the annual salary of the Probation Director shall be \$19,261.
- 7.
