The salary of the County Attorney shall be increased in the sum of \$1,955, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1989, the annual salary of the County Attorney shall be \$41,053.
- 2. The salary of the Commissioners of Election shall be increased in the sum of \$1,373 each, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1989, the annual salary of the Commissioners of Election shall be \$28,825 each.
- 3. The salary of the Public Defender shall be increased in the sum of \$1,550, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1989, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods.
