- Section 3. The commencement date of the Retirement Incentive Program shall be September 1, 1991. The open period for the Program as defined by the State Legislation, shall be forty-five (45)-days in length.
- Section 4. The actuarial present value of the additional retirement benefits payable pursuant to the provisions of this Local Law shall be funded over a five-year period. The amount of the annual payment in each of the five years shall be determined by the Actuary of the New York State Employee's Retirement System, and it shall be paid by the County of Niagara for each employee who receives the retirement benefits payable under this Local Law.
- Section 5. The Local Law shall be effective upon the filing of this law with the Secretary of State.
