## ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW SALARY INCREASE

- 1. The salary of the County Attorney shall be increased in the sum of \$1,421, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1995, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1995, the annual salary of the County Attorney shall be \$48,787.
- 2. The salary of the Commissioners of Election shall be increased in the sum of \$1,064, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1995, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1995, the annual salary of the Commissioners of Election shall be position no. 816.001 at \$36,528 and position no. 816.002 at \$36,978.
- 3. The salary of the Public Defender shall increased in the sum of \$1,069, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1995, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1995, the annual salary of the Public Defender shall be \$36,707.

Effective retroactive to January 1, 1995, the annual salary of the Director of Real Property Tax Services shall be \$40,854.
- 7. The salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be increased in the sum of \$1,605, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1995, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1995, the annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be \$55,558.
- 8. The salary of the County Auditor shall be increased in the sum of \$764, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1995, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1995, the annual salary of the County Auditor shall be \$26,240.
