**A LOCAL LAW SUPERSEDING COUNTY LAW SECTION 214 (2)
REGARDING PUBLICATION OF LOCAL LAWS**

Section 1: Purpose and Intent

The County Legislature of the County of Niagara intends by this Local Law to supersede the provisions of County Law Section 214 (2), which requires that a true copy of each local law be published in the official newspapers at least once a week for two (2) successive weeks. In order to reduce cost, this Legislature desires that the publication of the full text of each local law be discontinued and replaced with only that detail necessary to ensure that the public remains fully informed. This Local Law is adopted pursuant to Article IX of the Constitution of the State of New York, as interpreted in 92 Opinions of the Attorney General 1, and elsewhere.

Section 2: Publication Requirements

Upon the adoption of each local law by the County of Niagara, the Clerk of the Legislature shall cause the publication once in the official newspapers of the County of the notice of the adoption of said local law and an abstract of the provisions thereof. Said notice shall include the location and availability of a copy of the actual text of each local law. This publication shall be in lieu of that required by County Law Section 214 (2), which is hereby expressly superseded by this Local Law.

Section 3: Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
