A LOCAL LAW IN RELATION TO SMOKING IN NIAGARA COUNTY (RED-YELLOW-GREEN LIGHT POLICY)

SECTION 1.

The County will continue to be governed by the New York state smoking law contained in Article 13-E of the New York State Public Health Law.

SECTION 2.

All bars, restaurants and food service establishments shall post a sign outside their place of business indicating their smoking policy as follows:

a. A red sign to indicate smoking is permitted throughout the establishment. This option is only available to food service establishments seating less than forty-five (45) people;

b. A yellow sign to indicate smoking is permitted in designated areas only in compliance with Article 13-E of the New York State Public Health Law; and

c. A green sign to indicate that the establishment is smoke free.

SECTION 3.

Food service establishment is defined as set forth in Section 1399-N(5) of the New York State Public Health Law.

SECTION 4.

The signs to be posted shall be designated by the County of Niagara and made available to establishments prior to the effective date of this local law.

SECTION 5.

This local law shall be effective one hundred twenty (120) days after its enactment.
