A LOCAL LAW FOR THE REAPPORTIONMENT PLAN FOR THE COUNTY OF NIAGARA, NEW YORK

1. The Legislature powers of the County of Niagara shall be exercised by the County Legislature.
2. The County of Niagara shall be apportioned under a plan of apportionment consisting of nineteen (19) districts as described in the descriptions, maps, population for the districts and population summary sheet attached hereto and made a part of this Local Law.
3. The Niagara County Legislature, from the districts created herein, shall be first elected at the general election in the year 2003 and shall assume office January 1, 2004.
4. All other provisions of prior applicable local laws of Niagara County not in conflict with the provision herein shall remain in full force and effect.
5. This Local Law shall be subject to a Permissive Referendum.
6. This Local Law shall take effect on filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.

**FIRST LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT
COUNTY OF NIAGARA**

THE FIRST DISTRICT shall include that part of Niagara County within the City of Niagara Falls and the Town of Lewiston as described within the following boundaries:

its intersection with Packard Road; continuing East on the centerline of Simmons Avenue to its intersection with 38th Street; proceeding South on the centerline of 38th Street to its intersection with Royal Avenue; proceeding East on the centerline of Royal Avenue to its intersection with "G" Street; proceeding South on the centerline of "G" Street to its intersection with "A" Street; proceeding West on the centerline of "A" Street to its intersection with the centerline of Hyde Park Boulevard; proceeding South on the centerline of Hyde Park Boulevard as extended to the International Boundary in the Niagara River at the westernmost point of the Niagara County-Erie County border; proceeding West and North along the Niagara River (being the International Boundary) to its intersection with the southern border of the Power Project Forebay as extended West, being the point of beginning.

**SECOND LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT
COUNTY OF NIAGARA**

THE SECOND DISTRICT shall include that part of Niagara County within the City of Niagara Falls as described within the following boundaries:

FOURTH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT COUNTY OF NIAGARA

THE FOURTH DISTRICT shall include that part of Niagara County within the City of Niagara Falls as described within the following boundaries:

**FIFTH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT




