A LOCAL LAW ELECTING AN EARLY RETIREMENT INCENTIVE

- Section 1. The County of Niagara hereby to provide all of its eligible employees with a retirement incentive program authorized by Chapter 69 of the Laws of 2002.
- Section 2. The commencement date of the retirement incentive program shall be September 1, 2002 and extend to September 30, 2002 in which eligible employees may retire and receive the additional retirement benefit.
- Section 3. The actuarial present value of the additional retirement benefits payable pursuant to the provisions of this local law shall be paid as one (1) lump sum or in five (5) annual installments. The amount of the annual payment shall be determined by the actuary of the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System, and it shall be paid by the County of Niagara for each employee who receives the retirement benefits payable under this local law.
- Section 4. The County of Niagara hereby establishes the following policy with regards to positions that become vacant as a result of employees retiring under this incentive: upon the retirement of each such employee, the position shall be abolished. The department(s) affected by such may seek to then re-create such position(s), permission for such to be granted upon a showing of the necessity for the position to the relevant home legislative committee and to the

Human Resources Committee. The unanimous approval of each of the committee's is required (unanimous being defined as the affirmative vote of all committee members in attendance at a meeting where a quorum is present).
