ARTICLE III. EXECUTIVE BRANCH

§A3-3. Powers and Duties

The County Manager shall perform all the duties now and hereafter conferred or imposed upon the officer by law and directed by the County Legislature and shall have all powers and perform all the duties necessarily implied or incidental thereto.
