	County City of	Niagara	as follows:

1. Local Law No. 6 for the year 1994, as amended by Local Law No. 5 in 1998, as amended by Local Law No. 1 in 2003, and amended by Local Law No. 8 in 2004, is hereby further amended so as to amend the current provision thereof at Section 3, Subdivision (a) and insert therein a new Section 3 subdivision (a) to read as follows:

Section 3. Filling Vacancy in Elective Office of County Legislator.

(a) A vacancy, otherwise than by expiration of term, in the elective office of County Legislator, shall be filled by appointment by a majority vote of the duly elected members of the Niagara County Legislature. The vacancy and any holdover to such vacancy shall not be included in the total count for which there is to be a majority vote. The person newly appointed shall be a qualified elector of Niagara County, and shall be a resident of the Legislative District to which such appointment is made. The person so appointed shall hold office from the date of appointment through and until December 31st of the year of such appointment. Such vacancy shall be filled at the next succeeding General Election, and the person so elected shall take office on the day immediately following certification by the Niagara County Board of Elections of the results of such election and shall serve for the remainder of the term of such office of Niagara County Legislator.

2. This Local Law shall become effective 45 days after its adoption during which time said Local Law is subject to permissive referendum.
