This property was seized by the federal government on July 8th 2024. As of the date of possession by a government entity, that parcel becomes wholly exempt. The only charges that the federal government would be responsible for are any charges placed on the tax bill that were accrued before the July 8th 2024 possession date. These charges are: Town Charge for grass cuttings, Unpaid Sewer, Unpaid Water, and Water Late Fee. These charges total \$1,971.11.

This is an unlawful entry according to Real Property Tax Law 550 (7a). In light of this, the 2025 Niagara County/Town of Lewiston tax billing in the amount of \$15,252.68 shall be reduced by \$13,281.57 to \$1,971.11

Original billing: \$15,252.68

Revised billing: \$ 1,971.11
