WHEREAS, that Recording Officer has remitted the remaining monies collected to the County Treasurer for distribution to various Niagara County towns, villages and cities, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the sum of **\$1,863,795.38** reflects mortgage tax monies for the period October 1, 2024 through March 31, 2025 to be distributed, and the same be and hereby is, apportioned as follows among the various towns, villages and cities of the County of Niagara:
