NIAGARA COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY REPORT UPDATE ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) contributes to effective economic development in Niagara County's cities, towns and villages, through a locally based, regionally driven economic development planning process, and

WHEREAS, regions must prepare a new CEDS at least every five years for communities and organizations within the area to qualify for certain U.S. Economic Development Administration (EDA) funding, and

WHEREAS, Niagara County's last update of the CEDS was in 2020, which necessitates a new update to be completed and submitted by June 30, 2025, and

WHEREAS, the 2025 update of the CEDS is of additional importance as Niagara County is currently applying to the EDA for funding to assist with infrastructure upgrades at the new business park on Lockport-Junction Road, and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposal (RFP) for professional services to assist with the 2025 CEDS update was issued and publicly opened by the Purchasing Division on September 26, 2024, with six (6) firms responding, and

WHEREAS, a committee was designated to evaluate proposals and select the firm best qualified to effectively and efficiently accomplish the work outlined in the Request for Proposal, and

WHEREAS, after review, it was determined by the committee that Harrison Studio would be the best match for Niagara County to perform the duties required to update the Niagara County CEDS, based on the knowledge, experience and cost appropriate to the job, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Niagara County enter into an agreement with Harrison Studios for an amount not to exceed \$28,000 for the professional services related to the update of the Niagara County Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy, and be it further
