

# COURT-BASED MENTAL HEALTH NAVIGATOR PROGRAM



The Court-Based Mental Health Navigator Program assists and supports individuals in the community who are involved with the justice system in connecting to needed treatment, services and resources for their overall wellness. The program is voluntary and open to justice involved individuals charged with a felony or misdemeanor offense, who are in the community pending the outcome of their case and have mental health and related service needs.

Court-Based Mental Health Navigator Program staff are present at Court during court arraignment days and available to meet with individuals, provide screenings, linkages and information, and to answer any questions.
