The Niagara County Counseling and Wellness Services at locations in Lockport and Niagara Falls provide outpatient services to Niagara County residents, 5 years of age or older, who seek help for a range of behavioral health concerns and limited physical health concerns, including depression, anxiety, suicidal feelings, psychiatric illness, substance use, relapse prevention, basic primary care and wellness services.


