- register on ServNY:
 <u>https://apps.health.ny.gov/vms/appmanager/vms/public</u>
- fully complete and submit an application
- pass a criminal background check
- successfully complete NIMS ICS 100, 200,700, 800 and PFA 100
- Read the Policy and Procedures Manual and sign the Code of Ethics
- maintain medical credentials (if applicable)
- participate in communications drills that test the ability of the Health Department to make contact with volunteers
- * Volunteers are asked to participate in training and exercise opportunities
