Upon motion duly made by Steve Broderick and seconded by Mark C. Crocker, it was resolved that the Sewer District's September 2021 Financial Report be approved as presented. This motion was carried.

Administrative Directors Report:

a. 2022 Budget and Tax Computation Schedule – Mr. Blodgett reported he and Joanne

Teixeira met with the budget office on Tuesday, October 26, 2021 to review the tentative 2022 Budget.

The District's final budget will be presented to the Niagara County Legislature for approval in November.

Also, Mr. Blodgett stated that he would coordinate with John Shoemaker at Real Property for the final tax roll EDU numbers, which are typically available in early November. A final Tax Computation Spreadsheet will be forwarded to the Board as soon as possible once the final numbers are available.

b. Sanitary Chemist Position - Approval – Mr. Blodgett stated Commissioners were previously emailed the job application of Richard LaTona highlighting his experience with Occidental Chemical, which is scheduled to close in November. Mr. Blodgett requested authorization to provisionally hire Richard LaTona for the vacant Sanitary Chemist position.

Upon motion duly made by Joel M. Maerten and seconded by Steve Broderick, it was resolved that the Administrative Board of Niagara County Sewer District #1 hereby approves Mr. Blodgett's recommendation to provisionally hire Richard LaTona for the vacant Sanitary Chemist position. This motion was carried.

Mr. Blodgett also requested authorization to change the position of the Sanitary Chemist from 35 hours per week to 40 hours per week due to the work load required for this position.

Upon motion duly made by Mark C. Crocker and seconded by Joel M. Maerten, it was resolved that the Administrative Board of Niagara County Sewer District #1 hereby approves Mr. Blodgett's recommendation to change the position of the Sanitary Chemist from 35 hours per week to 40 hours per week due to the work load required for this position. This motion was carried.

c. Sodium Hypochlorite Bid – Approval (3 year) - Mr. Blodgett reported two bids were received for a three year contract period for Sodium Hypochlorite Solution (Bid #NCSD21-02) and noted the current price is \$0.678/gallon. JCI Jones Chemicals, Inc. submitted the lowest bid, however their bid included a qualifier indicating their price quoted was only valid through March 31, 2022 and would be subject to periodic changes with a 30 day notice to the District. Mr. Lannon stated these terms were a direct violation of New York State bidding laws. Mr. Vona concurred the bid as presented could not be considered a formal bid. Bison Laboratories, Inc. was the second bidder at \$1.49/gallon. Mr. Blodgett stated he anticipated an increase, but did not expect the cost would be this significant. However, he stated the District was able to adjust the chemical line in the 2022 budget to compensate for the increase. Mr. Blodgett is requesting Board approval to award said contract to Bison Laboratories in the amount of \$1.49/gallon for a three-year contract period.

Upon motion duly made by Steve Broderick and seconded by Joel M. Maerten, it was resolved that the Administrative Board of Niagara County Sewer District #1 hereby accepts the bid of Bison Laboratories, Inc. for Sodium Hypochlorite Solution (Bid #NCSD21-02) in the amount of \$1.49/gallon for a three-year contract period (December 1, 2021 – December 1, 2024). This motion was carried.

d. Proposal Request for 2021 SPDES Compliance Assistance – Mr. Blodgett reported that the District is required to give an annual update of the District's SPDES Compliance Items to the NYSDEC. Mr. Blodgett stated GHD will prepare a proposal to update and prepare the District's Annual

SPDES Compliance Reporting Items which will be presented for Board consideration at the November 2021 Administrative Board Meeting.

Upon motion duly made by Mark C. Crocker and seconded by Steve Broderick, it was resolved that the Administrative Board of Niagara County Sewer District #1 hereby approves Mr. Blodgett's request for GHD to prepare a proposal for the update of the District's Annual SPDES Compliance Reporting Items to be presented for Board consideration at the November 2021 Administrative Board Meeting. This motion was carried.

Mr. Lannon stated during initial discussions with the developer of Wheatfield Crossing he anticipated approving the project in phases to enable the District to evaluate the capacity burden the development placed on the District's infrastructure. The developer subsequently required the project be evaluated in its entirety. Based on discussions with District staff, Mr. Lannon suggested surcharging the developer \$1,000.00 per lot in anticipation of potential capacity upgrades which will be necessary in the future, upon the review of the Sewer District's attorney and notification of said proposal to the Town of Wheatfield Supervisor, Don MacSwan.

Upon motion duly made by Steve Broderick and seconded by Joel M. Maerten, it was resolved that the Administrative Board of Niagara County Sewer District #1 hereby approves Mr. Lannon 's request to surcharge the developer \$1,000.00 per lot in anticipation of potential capacity upgrades which will be necessary in the future, upon the review of the Sewer District's attorney and notification of said proposal to the Town of Wheatfield Supervisor, Don MacSwan. This motion was carried.
