Upon motion duly made by Mark C. Crocker and seconded by Don MacSwan, it was resolved that the Sewer District's August 2021 Financial Report be approved as presented. This motion was carried.

Administrative Directors Report:

- a. 2022 Budget Mr. Blodgett reported that the Tentative 2022 Budget for the Sewer District was submitted to the County, and he and Joanne Teixeira would be meeting with the County Manager and Budget Office within the next few weeks to review the Tentative Budget, and the District's final budget will be presented to the Niagara County Legislature for approval in December.
- b. 2022 Preliminary Tax Computation Schedule Mr. Blodgett distributed a spreadsheet containing each individual town's preliminary EDU numbers as provided to us by the Office of Real Property Tax Services. He stated he would coordinate with John Shoemaker at Real Property for the final tax roll EDU numbers, which are typically available in early November. He stressed these numbers are very preliminary and cautioned that major fluctuations due to Covid business shutdowns/reduced water usage, and suggested for town budgeting purposes to increase the preliminary numbers by a few percentages. A final Tax Computation Spreadsheet will be forwarded to the Board as soon as possible once the final numbers are available.
- c. Public Hearing Notification regarding Sewer District Assessment Mr. Blodgett reported that the District is responsible for notifying property owners subject to special assessments of the public hearing regarding the 2022 budget. In the past, postcards have been sent to property owners in the

Towns of Pendleton, Lewiston, and Wheatfield with assessments of \$350,000 and above. Mr. Blodgett requested Board authorization to send out said notifications for this year.

Upon motion duly made by Don MacSwan and seconded by Mark C. Crocker, it was resolved that the Administrative Board of Niagara County Sewer District #1 hereby authorizes Mr. Blodgett to notify property owners, subject to special assessments with assessed values of \$350,000 and above in the Towns of Lewiston, Pendleton, and Wheatfield, of the Public Hearing regarding the 2022 County Budget. This motion was carried.

d. 2022 Emergency Repair Contract - Mr. Blodgett reported the current Emergency Repair Contract expires on December 31, 2021. Mr. Blodgett requested authorization to work with GHD to seek bids for a three year emergency repair contract.

Upon motion duly made by Mark C. Crocker and seconded by Don MacSwan, it was resolved that the Administrative Board of Niagara County Sewer District #1 hereby authorizes Mr. Blodgett to work with GHD to seek bids for a three year emergency repair contract. This motion was carried.

- e. Sanitary Chemist Position Update Mr. Blodgett reported the one candidate on the existing civil service list was interviewed and the position has also been posted provisionally with 3 applications received so far. He stated potential candidates are not meeting all the qualifications as the job is currently posted. He thanked GHD and Teresa Misiti for specialized training of many of our operators on phosphorous, allowing us to continue doing that test in-house. He also expressed appreciation for the District operations and administrative staff and their willingness to pick up extra duties to assist during this transition period.
- f. Teamsters Contract Mr. Blodgett requested Board authorization for Chairman Wright
 H. Ellis to sign and execute the Teamsters Union Contract on behalf of the District.

Upon motion duly made by Don MacSwan and seconded by Steve Broderick, it was resolved that the Administrative Board of Niagara County Sewer District #1 hereby authorizes Chairman Wright H. Ellis to execute the Teamsters Union Contract. This motion was carried.
