Sterile Processing Technician:

A sterile processing technician maintains the cleanliness, functionality and inventory of healthcare instrumentation and equipment. As a sterile processing technician, you will be responsible for sterilizing instrumentation and equipment through a series of critical steps. This program prepares students for CBSPD Exam

Pharmacy Technician:

A pharmacy technician is the assistant to the pharmacist in a variety of settings including: Retail Pharmacy, Hospital Pharmacy, the Insurance industry and the Pharmaceutical Sales industry. Offshoots include working with Electronic Medical Records and IT opportunities within large hospital organizations. It is the job of the pharmacy technician to ensure that the pharmacy operates efficiently and safely. Some aptitude in math is required as well as the ability to prioritize tasks. Computer skills are required and the ability to type a plus. A High School Diploma or GED is required for the **Pharmacy Technician** Certification Exam \$129.00 (PTCB)

Emergency Medical Technician Original/Recert:

This course presents the National EMS Education Standards for the EMT. It consists of seven (7) modules that are based on the National Scope of Practice including: basic life support concepts, knowledge and skills to the prospective Emergency Medical Technician. Modules include Preparatory, Airway Management, Patient Assessment, Medical Emergencies, Trauma, Pediatric/Special needs Patients/Geriatric, and EMS Operations. The New York State EMT/AEMT BLS Protocols are introduced to the prospective student and practiced during lab sessions

Intro to AutoCAD – 40 Hours:

An introduction to AutoCAD instructs on how to use AutoCAD drafting software to create design layouts as well as industry quality drawings. You will gain the knowledge of drawing and modifying geometry, dimensioning and annotation, creating and using block libraries, as well as working with external references. Introduction to AutoCAD is a quality course to get you started on your way to creating industrial drawings.

Intro to Geometric Dimensioning & Tolerance: (21 Hours)

Drone Operator Training:

Intro to sUAS/Learn to Fly Course The 12-hour hands-on Intro to sUAS/Learn to Fly course teaches business and hobby pilots to fly safely and legally, understand new jobs and business models, and get the most out of their drones. Topics covered include flying multi-rotor & fixed wing drones, indoor flight training, diverse flight systems, maintenance, registration/certification requirements, safety, insurance, industry applications/technologies, and the latest FAA policies to legally operate a drone for any business purpose.

Intro to Solidworks – 45 Hours:
