Niagara WDB Youth Committee Meeting

Meeting Held: 2/26/19 at Niagara County Center for Economic Development/IDA

Attendees: Kathleen Granchelli of YWCA, Marilee Clark of Community Missions, Dawn Cody of Niagara County Employment & Training Department, Bonnie Rice of Niagara County Employment & Training Department, and John Accardo of Niagara Workforce Development Board.

Call-ins: Brian Rotella of Niagara Falls School District, Dawn Wylke of Lockport School District.

The Committee plans to host three separate "Ready to Employ" Recruitment Fairs, on site at each of the three major city school districts: Lockport, Niagara Falls, and North Tonawanda.

Initial plans are as follows:

- Arrange for 20-30 businesses to attend. Encourage businesses to send a person
 with hiring authority and to plan for brief interviews where appropriate. Limit to
 businesses with job openings that offer living wage jobs.
- Invite high school seniors who do not plan to attend college post-high school. These will not be summer jobs, but long-term employment opportunities.
- Trade Unions: invite apprenticeship and pre-apprenticeship programs to attend. Mention in invitations that ON-BOCES students will be attending.
- Mention the possibility of On-the-Job Training dollars (up to \$5,000 per new hire) and training scholarships (up to \$4,000 per student) in the business invitations.
- Ensure employers are engaging with youth at the event. This is meant to be an interactive experience with interviews and discussions with the youth about available job openings.
- Schools to be encouraged to prepare the seniors for interviews (interview attire, resumes, sample interview questions, workshops, e.g.).
- Employers will be able to direct seniors to a table to connect directly with possible new hire wage reimbursements or possible training dollars. For example, if a welding company wants to hire a senior who has no welding experience, the senior could qualify for \$4,000 in scholarship monies for welding training. For new hires, the employer could be reimbursed up to \$5,000 in wages (75% of wages) if the new hire will be trained by an existing employer.
