Attendees on the Conference Call: Kathleen Granchelli of YWCA, Dawn Wylke of Lockport School District, Dawn Cody of Niagara County Employment & Training Department, Bryan Rotella of Niagara Falls School District, and Bonnie Rice of Niagara County Employment & Training Department.

Initial discussion focused on the low response rate for the "Ready, Set, Work Niagara!" events. Lockport CSD has 5 businesses confirmed: Home Depot, GM, Reid Petroleum, Spectrum, and Elderwood. Niagara Falls CSD has only one, a hotel. Lockport CSD has 75 students potentially interested in attending the event. Dawn Wylke said she moved the mandatory senior graduation practice to the event date to encourage seniors to attend. Niagara Falls CSD has not begun recruiting students for the event. Bryan said he was waiting to see the business response before engaging the students. Bryan suggested getting the high school counselors involved earlier if we host a similar event next year.

It was decided that the Niagara Falls CSD event will be canceled and we will focus on the Lockport CSD event.
