 Retention - contact with 70 companies this YTD. 62 meetings with 52 companies. Expansions - Vishay is expanding again adding at 10K sq ft. building and increasing its 220 person workforce by 40. Vishay is a recipient of low cast power. Buffalo Pumps in NT is spending \$10m to modernize its plant. Agribusiness forum coming on March 14.
Featured Project: MT Altimeter LLC
Summary: This project will be an 80,000 square foot state of the art cold storage, micro-fulfillment facility which will also accommodate dry storage options. The facility will operate as an asset-light service structure that emphasizes agility, cost effectiveness, and customer-centricity.
