Awaiting results from WORC Grant submittal for Northern Border Regional Council on behalf of NCET, NCWDB, NC Econ Dev, and NC Mental Health. Thanks to Mike Casale for bringing this grant to the forefront!

Served as panelist for WDB Inclusion Committee's DEI How, What & Why - topic was "Where did the job seekers go?"

Free Northstar Digital Literacy training - will offer to One-Stop Partners for their job seeking customers. A4TD has already expressed interest.

Toured Laborers Local 91 Training Facility with Don Jablonski. Randy Palladino is in need of job seekers interested in learning a new trade and earning a living while being trained. Also has a collaboration with NFHS, providing training to high school seniors in the trades. Let Bonnie know if you'd like more info for local union training facilities, such as Electrical or Carpentry. There is a dire need for candidates.

Attended NYATEP Networking event at the Hyatt in NF, as did Mike Casale and Karen Kwandrans.

Oculus VR Headsets with TransfrVR training in Career Exploration and various fields such as automotive, health care, customer service: One headset is now in the Niagara Falls Career Center, with the ability to borrow up to 15 headsets for events. This will help attract customers to our services, provide career exploration for customers, and provide free training and certifications for certain career fields. Awaiting the ability to create user accounts for our Career Center team.

Disability Resource Coordinator: Collaborating with our local DRC team to submit SCION-DRC Asset Map, Implementation Plan, and Sustainability Plan. This will be Year 2 of a 5-year grant.

Adult Priority Population: There is a new NYSDOL performance measure to serve at least 50.1% of Adults who are either basic skills deficient, English Language Learners, receiving PA benefits, or low income. The process is more intense for our Career Center team, but training will continue as usual, with the exception of Customized Training. Please continue to refer individuals to our training programs as usual.

Customized Training: We are in a holding pattern for CT because of the new performance measure. All CT customers are a negative hit against the performance. This may change as we become more familiar with our performance outcomes.
