The response from job seekers is less encouraging at present but now that the \$600 PUA is completed job seekers may be more amenable. Career Fairs We are planning on doing something along the lines of virtual career fair although there is no time frame of when this will happen. Our challenge is that many of the people we serve do not have access to a computer or have limited computer skills needed. Drive through career fair model is also a possibility. Bonnie offered information about one happening in Ontario County and there appears to have been one in Erie county recently.
Career Center Chandra W	Career Center at Trott is now opened without appointment five days per week. Hours are 8.30a to 3p weekdays with closure from noon to 1 for sanitization. A maximum of seven people are allowed in per hour. Persons wishing to visit the center must knock at the door to gain admittance when there is room. Customer flow is slower than before. Temps are taken at the door. Business is starting to use the center for recruitment (Remedy Staffing is coming in on Thursdays from 9-Noon and BOCES will use the center for resume workshops on Fridays)

WDB Bonnie R	The reopening of the career center at Trott will receive some more publicity thru the county legislature and the media. Summer Youth, We have 81 youth employed so far for this program that extends until September 30. We are still looking for work sites. The hiring process has need expedited through the use of a contacted payroll service. NCCC Karen K	Pharm Tech August 24th class is full. Last certification for the year is 12/20. Several county businesses have hired and are seeking our graduates including: NFMMC, Pine Pharmacy, Summit. Instructors are great. Medical Billing- Starting September 1. Partnership has made it possible to use the MedEx software for training purposes. This program is now used extensively in the industry. Sterile Processing class full have increased number of students to 18 per class, next class in October. Google IT Support -Getting positive feedback from participants. New class begins on September 14. NCCC was selected for the second round of the Workforce Development Grant funding and if selected for the \$1.6M grant will focus upon upskilling in trades such as electrical, machining and welding
OTDA Jola S	Back in the office. Have received training for customer service work associated with EBT program which provides equivalent \$ in lieu of free school lunches. OTDA employees provide customer service for those calling in about this program. May also be pulled in for UI customer service as well.
