STATS AND UPDATES ONE STOP SYSTEM OPERATOR

From July 1, 2021 to present

- 48 people hired using WIOA funded On-the-Job Training
- 64 people received WIOA scholarships for training in demand occupations
- 81 youth have enrolled in WIOA Youth programs
 - 22 have received either High School Diploma or GED
 - 13 enrolled in either college or the military
 - 7 are getting their NYS Driver's License

Additional Grants:

NYS Grant to extend the Summer Youth Employment Program

• put an additional 50 youth to work beyond the summer program

NYSGVP

- 11 youth directly hired by local employers
 - Employers will receive a 90% wage reimbursement up to \$4,000 per employer for training theses youth in their new duties.
 - We have until 2023 to hire 50 youth using the grant money

Disability Resource Coordinator:

We received a SCION-DRC grant to extend our DRC program assists individuals with disabilities in navigating their return to work.

- \$100,000 per year for 3 years, for a total of \$300,000 in funding
- Our DRC is a trained Benefits Advisor and assists individuals with understanding how work
