 \Rightarrow On <u>December 1st</u> the new Overtime Rule takes effect

The Overtime Rule raises the salary threshold of salaried workers eligible for overtime pay in a given pay period to \$913 per week or \$47,476 annually. For more information go to <u>https://www.dol.gov/featured/overtime/</u>

 \Rightarrow <u>December</u> will also see a Minimum Wage increase
