Call to Attention: Manufacturing Companies in the WNY Area

The Dream It Do It Advanced Manufacturing Program (DIDIAMP) partners with local schools and innovative manufacturers to build the next generation of manufacturing talent through hands-on experiences and real-world career connections. Since 2009, the program has engaged Western New York's pool of nearly 80,000 students in grades 8-12, with over 1,400 currently enrolled and waiting to connect with manufacturers.

DIDIAMP offers multiple partnership opportunities including networking with educators and students, onboarding to the Tallo platform for talent connections, participating in applied learning events, and hosting industry tours. Manufacturers can invest through tax-deductible contributions, endorse the program, and attend events across Erie, Niagara, and Chautauqua counties. The program's digital partner Tallo provides a complimentary platform to showcase companies and share opportunities.
